- **Recent Graduate Teacher from Greenwich University (Distance Learning)**
 - Course had VLE with assignments and forums
 - Part of our teaching portfolio had to have evidence of using online forums to discuss teaching practices/issues
- **Open University**
 - Currently undergoing a unit “Science of Archaeology” – 100% distance learning
- **Moodle User in FE**
 - Use of Moodle as a Course Leader in FE
 - Use of Moodle as a member of the Marketing team – Moodle was used for internal website (intranet)

Benefits

- **Accessibility**
 - Dyslexia, partially sighted, location, speakers of other languages
- **Flexibility**
 - Student centred, at a touch of a button, not fixed (allow for further exploration)
- **Collaboration**
 - No need for constant human contact
- **Multimedia**
 - Variety of display formats
- **Learning styles**
 - Auditory, Visual and Kinaesthetic learners

VLEs as Tools

- **Course specific**
 - Units, assignments, useful websites, forums, quizzes, advice
- **Generic**
 - Library, uni docs, careers, key skills, degree calculator
